Greetings, I hope that you are doing well.

Regarding the Public Health Order 8: Cloth Face Coverings or Masks [<https://www.asafenashville.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/06/Order-8-FACE-MASKS-FINAL-SIGNED-V4-Amended-Children-section.pdf>], I would like to have some clarification please.

According to the World Health Organization (WHO) and the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), there is a global pandemic due to the infectious viral organism called the SARS-CoV-2 virus (coronavirus); however, on 2 November 2020, the CDC [<https://www.fluoridefreepeel.ca/wp-content/uploads/2020/11/USA-CDC-Virus-Isolation-Response-Scrubbed.pdf>] stated that “**A search of our records failed to reveal any documents pertaining to your request.**” in response to a FOIA request for records concerning the isolation of the same SARS-CoV-2 virus.

I recently made a Public Records Request for both the State of Tennessee Department of Health & the Metro Public Health Department regarding the isolation and purification of the SARS-CoV-2 virus (coronavirus). The isolation and purification of a possible infectious agent are procedures within scientific postulates for scientifically determining disease causation from a microorganism.

There are 2 sets of postulates {Friedrich Gustav Jacob Henle-Robert Koch's Postulates & Thomas M. River's Postulates} that need to be fully satisfied to scientifically prove that a microorganism, in this case a virus, is indeed the cause of the disease, in this case COVID-19. From my research, I have not found a single record that demonstrates either the isolation and/or the purification of the SARS-CoV-2 virus (coronavirus).
